

SWIMMING POOL COMPLIANCE

Is Your Pool Compliant?

In NSW, the owners of properties with a swimming pool and/or a spa pool are required to register their pools and spas on the Swimming Pool Register. To search if your pool is on the NSW Swimming Pool Register or to register your pool, click here: [Swimming Pool Register](#).

To meet the swimming [pool fence regulations](#) in **NSW** and to [avoid getting a non-compliance certificate](#) after a pool compliance inspection, you should go through a proper evaluation on your pool safety. Here is a self-assessment checklist in 2019 to determine if your pool is compliant with the Australian Standards (*NSW Pool Fencing Law*)

Applications for Certificates of Compliance and information on the fees applicable are available by contacting Council's Customer Service Team on 02 6740 2100.

Rental properties with swimming pools must be issued with a Certificate of compliance every 3 years to ensure the pool and surrounds are safe. The Gunnedah Shire Council fee in December 2019 was \$150 for this compliance certificate (cost is subject to change).

Additionally, before erecting or installing a new swimming pool homeowners must obtain either [Development Consent](#) and a [Construction Certificate](#) or a [Complying Development Certificate](#).
