Numbers increased to 475 up 150 head. Most of the regular buyers were in attendance, however not all operating. It was once again a very good yarding with the bulk of the penning made up of yearlings with suitable cattle for both feedlot and processors. There were 130 cows offered.

- Best prime vealers were fully firm and topped at 450 c/kg
- Feedlot steer orders were again very active under 500kg feeders were close to firm possibly 4-5 c/kg cheaper. Heavier weight steers 500kg going to feedlot orders fell 20-30 c/kg
- Yearling steers selling to processors up to 480kg sold 5-8 c/kg cheaper, while Heavy weight steers and bullocks fell 30 c/kg
- Yearling heifers varied with quality & breed. A pen of Euro X heifers sold to feedlot for a top of 451 c/kg, which was 20 c/kg dearer. The balance sold firm to 15 c/kg easier.
- An excellent offering of prime cows this sale including a consignment of Heavy D4/D5 cows, 64 in total. They average 740kg & 306.6 c/kg Topping at 312.6 c/kg. they averaged \$2270
- Bulls fell 15 c/kg
