With no sale next week. Numbers increased to 580 head up 180 cattle. Most grades were represented, with cows and weaners being in the majority. There were some very well presented vealers penned in prime condition, they generally saw little change other than quality related. Light weight restocking steers met weaker demand to be 10-15c/kg cheaper. Medium weight feeder steers eased 4-5c/kg, while heavier weight feeder steers sold close to firm. Those processors were firm. Yearling heifers to processors saw no change. Those to feed slipped 5-10c/kg. Heavy export steers/heifers were fully firm. Steers topped at 278.2 c/kg and the heifer portion at 258.2 c/kg. Good numbers of cows again this sale. Best prime heavy cows sold 5-8 c/kg cheaper and medium weight cows slipped 10-15c/kg Bulls 15-20 c/kg dearer. Reduced competition on restocking weaners saw them sell 20 c/kg cheaper for the steer portion and 30 c/kg cheaper for the heifer
