After some of the best falls of rain last week, numbers were reduced to 150 cattle. A full field of buyers competed in another very solid market. Approximately 80 cows and heifers made up the bulk of the penning. Reduced numbers of feeders this sale.

- Light/medium weight Angus feeder steers sold fully firm topping at 441 c/kg.
- Restockers were active on suitable lines, however there were reduced lines. Grown heifers returning to the paddock sold to 391 c/kg.
- 4 & 6 tooth export heifers gained 20 c/kg, however, were better quality than previous weeks.
- A very good offering of cows saw prices jump 15-20 c/kg dearer. Best meaty cows sold to a top of 300 c/kg.
- Prime D4 & D5 cows sold to a high of 298.2 c/kg, up 20 c/kg, with quality playing a major factor.
- Bulls similar to prime cows.
