With some good & well-deserved rainfall around the district, numbers were reduced to 250 head. Most of the yarding were made up of calves and light weaners. 3 to 4 pens of forward conditioned feeder steers and heifers. All regular buyers were in attendance and competing in an exceptionally strong market.

- Limited offering of prime local trade met solid demand and reached a high of 400c/kg, up 40c/kg
- Two attractive pens of well bred & forward conditioned Angus feeder steers sold to 399.2 c/kg, up 40-45c/kg
- Calves and light weaners made up the largest percentage of the yarding.
- Terrific rainfalls in parts of the district, local restockers competed fiercely with outside orders.
- Eight steer calves from 150-230kg sold to a high of 450c/kg, most selling from 400 to 440 c/kg.
- The heifer portion sold to a top of 409.2 c/kg.
- Only a handful of cows and bulls yarded.
- Best heavy cows sold to 282 c/kg
- Bulls to 285.6 c/kg
