Numbers lifted this week for a yarding of 580 cattle, up 120 head. Once again it was a high-quality yarding with the majority presenting in fat condition. Most buyers were present except for a Northern cow processor. Overall, the market remained firm from the previous week.

- An exceptionally good line up of vealers & prime young trade cattle, topping at 431.2c/kg with the majority operating between 400 to 420c/kg
- Supermarket weight yearlings sold close to firm with good numbers supplied
- Feeder steers were mostly unchanged with buyers a little more selective on type and condition. Feeder heifers were fully firm.
- Restocking weaners were again in demand and sold to a top of 546c/kg for a pen of light steer calves, and 474.6 c/kg for 260kg Angus steers
- Limited of cows offered this week as they generally sold fully firm to last week.
- Bulls sold 10-20 c/kg cheaper
