Numbers increased to 520 cattle, up by 300 head. Overall it was a much improved quality yarding- especially the local trade butcher cattle. The bulk of the yarding was made up of yearling steers and heifers. Also good numbers of cows were penned. Prime conditioned young trade cattle met strong demand to be fully firm to 5c/kg dearer. Feeder steers and heifers sold 5-10c/kg cheaper. The few export steers and heifers sold similar to last sale, with a pen of prime heavy weights selling to 245c/kg. Prime heavy D4 cows gained 3c/kg topping at 204.6 c/kg while best clear medium weight reached 197.2. Plain store cows ranged from 110-150c/kg. Bulls saw no change
