Quality was mixed in a reduced yarding at Mudgee compared to the previous sale, with numbers easing to 1,063 head, back from 1,310 head at the previous market. Buyer attendance remained solid with the usual processors, feeders and restockers operating, although competition was not as strong across several categories.

Lamb quality was more inconsistent this week, particularly through the secondary and lighter weight runs, which resulted in softer prices overall. Trade and heavy crossbred lambs met fair competition, however they were unable to reach the highs of the previous sale. Heavy lambs topped at \$289/head, back from \$346/head at the earlier market, while the overall lamb average also eased. Merino lambs were limited in numbers and sold to mixed competition. Hoggets were penned in similar quality although not to the exceptional standard of the previous sale. Demand remained selective with the better finished lines attracting the strongest interest. Crossbred hoggets sold to a top of \$242/head, easing from the previous market where they reached \$298/head.

Mutton numbers remained solid with a fair offering of crossbred and Merino sheep. Heavy sheep continued to attract processor interest, although rates were generally easier in line with the softer lamb market. Crossbred sheep sold to \$296/head, while Merino sheep topped at \$150/head. Competition for lighter conditioned sheep was more subdued.

Overall, the market reflected softer trends across most categories as buyers became more selective on secondary stock.
