After a little bit of rain over the long weekend, numbers were reduced to 550 cattle. It was one of the plainest quality/conditioned yarding seen for a while. Very few prime trade cattle penned. They were unchanged. There were several pens of light/medium weight feeder steers, they met solid competition to be fully firm. No heavy weight feeders yarded. Prime yealing heifers were also fully firm, with a very good pen of heavy weights reaching 269.2c/kg, up by 10c/kg. Majority of the yarding was made up of plain weaners and cows. Weaners met good demand to finish mostly unchanged. Plain cows saw extra activity from an extra order. They sold firm to 10c/kg dearer. Prime medium/heavy cows sold 5-6c/kg. Bulls unchanged
