Numbers remained similar for a yarding of 380 cattle, down by 40 head. Cows & yearling cattle to kill made up the majority of the yarding. All buyers were present & competing. The odd top quality milk vealers re-appeared selling to 330.6 cents, up by 10 -15c/kg. A very good run of supplementary fed yearling steers & heifers attracted strong bidding from the processor section, to also sell 10c/kg dearer. Feeder steers held last weeks gains. Export heifers sold to 283.2c/kg for the better/heavier end 500kg +, while the lighter end sold to 245c/kg. Not the good run of heavy steers/bullocks as the previous 2 weeks, they were back 15c/kg. Heavy cows sold 8 -10c/kg cheaper topping @ 240.2c/kg for a single 630kg cow, while most trading between 175-220c/kg. Bulls sold to fully firm.
