The last sale in Mudgee for 2022 saw a reduced yarding of 250 cattle, down 550 head. Not all regular buyers were operating. However, the market was mostly dearer. The majority of the penning consisted of vealers a yearlings, with representatives of both prime and feedlot types. A select single vealer topped at 539.2 c/kg, however the majority traded between 420 & 490 c/kg.

Extra buying competition saw backgrounding and feedlot types sell to a dearer trend. Generally, 10-15 cents up. A few lots may have sold more than that. Light and medium types sold to a high of 500 cents, while heavier weights feeders (440kg plus) sold to a high of 471.2 c/kg

The majority of the yearling heifers went to background/feedlotters and generally sold between 370-420 cents.

There were few export steers/heifers to get an accurate quote, although competition was keener. Cows gained a bit of last sales cheaper prices. Best heavy D4/D5. Cows topped at 340 cents which was 25 cents up.

Bulls saw very little change.
