Numbers lifted by 100 head for a yarding of 925 cattle. Once again it was a good quality yarding, with some better finished medium weight steers & heifers penned along with a good yarding of cows. Not the quality in the feeder steers as the previous couple of weeks. An even split of 350 steers & heifers yarded, aswell as 200 cows. All regular buyers/orders were in attendance. Only a handful of prime vealers penned, they sold 10c/kg dearer. A very handy penning of prime yearlings suitable for the heavy trade, they sold fully firm to 5c/kg better. Feeder steers slipped 15c/kg on last weeks high rates, while the heifer portion was less affected falling 6-10c/kg, mostly quality related. Heavy grown cattle sold to dearer trends, once again all the action from the southern processors. Steers topping @ 334.2c/kg & heifers @ 325.2c/kg. Cows met solid competition to finish 10-20c/kg better on the heavies & up to 10c/kg better on the working cows. Bulls remained unchanged.
