First sale back after Easter & after some good falls of rain the previous 2 weeks saw agents yard 180 cattle. The yarding consisted of mainly cows presenting in good condition, along with the usual yearling cattle. All buyers were in attendance, with a returning southern processor. The market held firm. Young cattle suitable for local butcher orders topped at 430c/kg. The better bred feeder steers 400kg + sold to a top of 410c/kg. Best heavy cows sold to strong competition, most selling between 260-276c/kg. Restockers were active on young/lighter cattle, as well as plain cows. Angus steers to go back in the paddock made between 426.2c/kg - 474.2c/kg. Plain cows to restockers sold to 283.c/kg.
