Numbers increased to 630 head, up by 400 after last weeks small yarding. This week saw some very good cattle yarded, in all categories. The odd milk vealer re-appeared selling to 311 cents for the heavy ones & 290.6 cents for light vealers. Supplementary fed yearling steers attracted strong bidding from the processor section, to be fully firm on last week. Heavy/medium weight feeder steers were mostly unchanged, however the lighter feeder steers or backgrounders slipped a further 10c/kg. Feeder heifers were very similar to the steer portion, firm for the heavier types & cheaper for lighter weights. There were several pens of prime heavy steers/bullocks, a credit to the vendors to present such an article in a season like this. They sold to a top of 288.2 cents. Also a very good line up of prime conditioned heavy weight cows. Best cows topped at 212c/kg, up 25 cents. Handy medium weight cows 5 -10 cents dearer & plain light cows 20 cents up. Light weaners were again hard to move, falling a further 10-20 cents. Bulls 5-10 cents dearer.
