A slight increase in numbers from the sale a fortnight ago for a total yarding of 600 head. All regular buying orders were present & competing in a dearer market.

It was a very good quality yarding with some outstanding trade cattle & cows offered.

- Prime vealers sold to a high of 425.2 c/kg, up 15 c/kg from the previous sale.
- Yearling steers to trade processing orders sold firm for the best & up to 20 c/kg dearer for the balance with southern processors the most active.
- Light weight yearling steers going to backgrounding & feeder orders sold 10 – 20 c/kg dearer. The heifer portion sold 5-10 c/kg dearer.
- Heavier weight yearlings sold 5-8 c/kg up.
- A particularly good yarding of prime cows sold to keen buyer interest with 2 additional cow orders. Best heavy prime cows D4 topped at 2.96 c/kg which was 10-12 c/kg up. While medium weight cows sold to 290 c/kg.
- Bulls lost c/kg to top at 280 c/kg
- Restockers were again active. Light weight steers under 200 kg sold to 570 c/kg & the heifer portion to 480 c/kg.
