Numbers increased slightly (30 head) for a total yarding of 780 cattle. It was a mostly good quality yarding with plenty of well bred cattle. The yearling cattle had both prime cattle and feedlot types. Good numbers of cows penned. One buyer was absent, however his orders were covered. Prime vealers to the butchers sold fully firm to top at 320c/kg. The heifer portion to 290 c/kg. Feedlot types competed strongly on suitable types and weights. Both steers and heifers. Angus steers sold to a tops of 320.4 c/kg, no change on last sale. Euro x types sold to 308 c/kg, up 5-6 c/kg. Suitable feeder heifers sold fully firm 260-290 c/kg. Heavy export cattle sold 5-8 c/kg dearer. Steer portion was firm, while the heifer portion gained 5 c/kg. A good supply of cows were again well supported. Best prime heavy cows firm while the secondary grades sold 10 c/kg dearer. Bulls firm.
