With the season & cattle improving numbers increased by 200 head for a total yarding of 950 cattle. Cattle quality & condition improved with all regular buyers attending in another very solid market. Prime local trade types sold firm for the very best but a little cheaper for the majority. Yearling steers & heifers made up the biggest % of the offering with most going to back grounding & feedlot orders. Angus steers selling to feedlotters sold firm to a fraction cheaper 5 to 10 cents however cross breeds sold 10 to 12 cents stronger. Heifers selling to backgrounding & feedlots sold 10 to 15 cents stronger with most making 450 to 480 cents. Prime grown cattle met solid demand from the processors. They improved 10 to 12 cents. Besty heavy steers weighing over 600 kg sold to a high of 514.2 cents and returned \$3,154. Most heavy heifers to processors sold from 470 to 500 cents. Cows lifted 5 to 10 cents and topped at 428 cents. Bulls saw a big lift in values gaining 20 cents and topping at 435.2
