It was a mixed quality yarding with 260 cattle penned, up 100 head on last week. There were some very good butchers cattle penned along with the plainer restocking types. A feature line of 60 grain fed cows, Angus & Euro Crosses. A full field of buyers with an additional supermarket buyer in attendance all competed in a very strong market. Young Euro cattle to the trade were up to 30c/kg dearer topping @ 448c/kg for steers & 430c/kg for heifers. Restocking & Light weight Angus steers topped @ 460.2c/kg, while the light weight cross bred types topped @ 458.2c/kg. Feedlotters competed strongly on medium weight Angus steers selling to 451.2c/kg, dearer by 10-20c/kg dearer. Grown/export heifers sold to dearer trends, most selling between 300c/kg - 356.2c/kg. Cows were the feature this week with a supermarket order operating on the better 3 & 4 scores, resulting in gains of 10-12c/kg. Best heavy cows topping @ 313.2c/kg, coming back at over \$2000/hd. Bulls also gained 10-12c/kg
