Numbers eased to 300 cattle, down 28 head. All regular buyers were present and competing in a slightly cheaper market.

It was once again a pretty handy yarding of local trade cattle. They generally sold 5-8 c/kg cheaper compared to last weeks high rates.

- Light and medium weight steer and heifer yearlings to slaughter came off 5-6 c/kg
- Whilst those to feed fell 5-10 c/kg
- Restocking types 260-320 fell 10c/kg on limited numbers
- No supermarket orders this week, which saw cattle in this specs fall 10-15 c/kg
- Most of the export types fell into the older end of 4 & 6 teeth. They were mostly unchanged
- Cows were close to firm
- Bulls firm to 5 c/kg easier
