Numbers more than doubled this week for a yarding of 465 cattle. Overall it was a mostly good quality yarding. Most regular buying orders were present and competing in a dearer market. Cows were again presented in the majority and made up a big percentage of the penning. There was a very good run of prime vealers and more numbers seen for quite a while. Prime euro vealers met very solid competition, mostly from southern operators, selling 30c/kg dearer and topping at 315.6c/kg. While the heifer portion sold 240-290c/kg. Not a lot of feeder steers today, however they were 5-10 c/kg dearer. Feeder heifers 10-15c/kg up. Not a lot of export steers/heifers penned however they sold fully firm. It was a handy yarding of cows. Best prime heavy D4 cows sold 10c/kg dearer. While good clean boning and medium weight cows 10-15c/kg dearer. Bulls up to 15c/kg dearer.
