Numbers increased to 1390 cattle, up 200 head. All regular buyers were in attendance and operating. Feeder & backgrounding cattle were in the majority & sold to a dearer trend. The few prime yearling cattle sold fully firm to 5c/kg dearer. Less cows this sale & they met weaker competition. Best local trade cattle sold to 307c/kg, up 10c/kg, while the heifer portion to the processors sold 5-7c/kg dearer. A bigger line up of feeder steers & heifers saw keener interest & demand. Medium weight steers sold to 295.2c/kg which was a gain of 10c/kg, heifers also increased by 5-8c/kg. Heavy export types, steers & heifers sold fully firm to 5c/kg dearer. Reduced numbers of cows this sale saw weaker demand. Prices slipped 20-30c/kg from last weeks very good market. Prime heavy weights sold to a top of 246.2c/kg while medium weight boner cows topped at 228c/kg. Bulls sold slightly cheaper & topped at 281.6c/kg.
