McDonald Lawson Carter Market Report

With good rain across the district, numbers fell sharply to 480 head following the larger offerings of recent sales. Despite the smaller yarding, competition remained strong across most categories, particularly through feeder and processor lines, with buyers continuing to show confidence for well-bred cattle.

Prime vealers remained limited in numbers but continued to attract strong competition. Vealer steers sold to a high of 470.0c/kg, remaining firm on recent improved rates, while secondary types were more price sensitive. Heifer vealers also held solid demand.

Yearling cattle made up the bulk of the yarding with a few good lines of supplementary-fed and well-finished lines but mostly secondary cattle presented. Yearling steers reached a top of 568.2c/kg, improving on the previous sale's 546.2c/kg, with Angus yearling steers averaging 515.1c/kg. Feeder buyers remained very active, particularly on medium and heavy weight Angus cattle suited to feedlot orders. Charolais and Hereford steers also attracted strong competition, with several categories improving 10–20c/kg on the previous sale. Yearling heifers continued the upward trend, with Angus heifers averaging 427.3c/kg and better lines selling to 468.2c/kg.

Cow numbers were considerably lower, however quality remained very good. Heavy cows sold in a firm to slightly dearer market, with the best cows reaching 390.0c/kg. Angus cows averaged 335.0c/kg, remaining firm on the previous sale, while well-finished heavy cows generally sold between 320–380c/kg. Processor competition remained strong throughout the cow run.

Heavy bulls continued to meet solid demand topping at 375.0c/kg

Overall, the market continued its recent upward trend, with the strongest gains again evident through feeder yearling cattle. Useful rain and reduced numbers combined to lift several categories a further 10–20c/kg, while cows and vealers generally remained firm on the stronger market established in the previous sale.
