With no sale for a fortnight numbers increased to 745 cattle, up by 395 head. It was one of the best yarding's of prime conditioned cattle seen in Mudgee for an exceptionally long time. The majority were presented with plenty of weight and there were very few restocking types. A full field of buyers were present along with a couple of extra backgrounding orders.

- Prime local trade vealers & lighter weights suitable for local butchers & wholesalers lost 15-20 c/kg compared to a very solid sale for these types 2 weeks ago.
- Yearling steers & heifers were well presented with plenty of weight & cover. They sold close to firm.
- Feedlotters competed strongly with any suitable lots gaining very strong competition to be 10-20 c/kg dearer.
- Heavy steers & heifers were firm to 5 c/kg easier.
- Cows were firm to 6 c/kg softer, although an individual Limo x Cow made to 328.2 c/kg.
- Bulls gained 15-20 c/kg
