505 Fair to good quality cattle. Up by 120 head. Most grades were represented. All regular buyers were present & active. Prime conditioned local tade cattle were fully firm topping at 324.6 cents. There was increased numbers of yearling steers & heifers suitable to the feedlotter. Angus steers again attracted solid competition selling to 314.6 cents which was fully firm on last weeks rates. A better offering of yearling heifers saw prices jump 10 to 15 cents with quality a contributing factor. Not large numbes of heavy export steers/heifers, however they were mostly unchanged. Cow numbers increased. Best heavy/prime cows fell a few cents however the plainer cows lifted 3 to 4 cents. Bulls fell 10 cents. A run of splitter calves topped at \$230 p/head and sold down to a low of \$100.
