Quality remained mixed at this week's Mudgee Fat Sheep and Lamb sale, with yardings increasing to 499 head from 427 head at the previous sale. Buyer attendance remained consistent, with regular processors and local competition operating throughout the market. While numbers lifted slightly, competition was more selective across most categories, particularly on secondary and lighter conditioned stock.

Crossbred lambs accounted for the majority of the offering and continued to attract solid processor interest. However, prices eased from the previous sale, with heavy lambs topping at \$314/head, back from \$362/head. The overall quality was more variable, with well-finished trade and export lambs maintaining strong competition, while lighter and plainer lambs sold to softer rates. Merino lambs were offered in limited numbers and topped at \$116/head.

Hoggets were again penned in only small numbers, with Crossbred hoggets selling to \$254/head, easing from the previous sale where they reached \$328/head. Buyer demand remained strongest for heavy, well-finished lines.

Mutton numbers remained relatively light. Merino ewes sold to \$140/head, while the single pen of Crossbred ewes made \$200/head. Crossbred sheep reached \$71/head, with Crossbred wethers topping at \$200/head.
