After missing 1st weeks sale, numbers fell by 90 head for a total yarding of 505 cattle. A full field of buyers and the return of a Hunter processor were at the rail and competing in a dearer market. It was again a very good quality yarding with prime cattle presented in each category. A very good selection of prime vealers sold to solid competition to be fully firm from the last sale. Topping at 428.2 c/kg. Light trade weight yearlings also reached to 423.2 c/kg to the processors. Heavier weight yearling steers 400kg plus sold to 395c/kg to the processors, which was fully firm to 7c/kg dearer. Heifers also traded at dearer rates. Trade operators competed strongly to push them 5-7c/kg dearer. The heavier weights 400 kg and better gained 10c/kg. Heavy export types were firm for the types however gained 10-15c/kg for 6-8 tooth types. Cows were well supplied and sold very similar. Mayber 2-3 c/kg dearer. Bulls gained 10-15 c/kg. Restocking tyoes were fully firm to 10c/kg dearer.
