200 Cattle yarded down by 200 head. Insufficient cattle suitable for the local trade saw prices slip 5 to 10 cents. Yearling heifers to trade orders sold to 310 cents. Majority of the yarding consisted of yearlings more suited to feedlotter. Steer portion held fairly steady to sell to 295 cents while 300 to 350 kg heifers were dearer by 10 cents. A smart pen of export weight heifers 485 kg sold to a top of 283.6 cents 10 cetes dearer on last week. Cows saw the biggest jump with a pen of angus, medium weight & meaty cows sold to 259.2 cents up by 25 cents. Heavy weight cows sold to 249.2 cents. Bulls sold from 246.2 to 255 cents dearer by 15 cents. Restockers competed strongly on any suitable cattle.
