Numbers eased slightly, for a yarding of 675 cattle. Down 50 head. Very few local trade cattle offered. They generally sold 5-10c/kg cheaper. There was a bigger number of vealers, straight off the cows earlier than normal - around 220 - 260kg. The steer portion sold dearer than last sale, making to 338.6c/kg to restockers. However the heifer portion met restricted competition to be up to 20c/kg cheaper. Yearling steers to feedlotters were back 5c/kg and the heifer portion fell 10-15c/kg. Older plain conditioned steers met limited competition to be firm to 20c/kg back. Some only making cow money. There was a handy offering of export steers & heifers. They saw the best of the market, with no real change in prices seen. Best heavy cows fell 10 - 12c/kg, while plain medium weight cows fell 15-20c/kg. Bulls firm, selling to 265.6c/kg.
