With over 100mls or rain falling over the four days prior numbers were reduced to 225 cattle, down 200 head from the previous sale a fortnight ago. It was a good quality yarding with a good offering of euro cross yearling steers and heifers, and an excellent penning of 120 Angus plus Angus cross & Charolais Cross feeder steers principally 460-520 kg. All but one of the regular buyers were present and completed in a dearer market.

- Approximately 30 quality Charolais cross yearlings 340-400 kg sold to strong demand from the processing buyers, they sold from 450-478.6 c/kg, up 25 to 30 cents dearer.
- A consignment of 120 Angus, Black Baldy & Charolais/Angus Cross steers 460-530kg also sold to a dearer trend.
- 60-470kg straight Angus steers sold to 469.2 c/kg, 512kg sold to 462 c/kg.
- The Charolais Cross steers 484kg sold to 415.2 Charolais, 530kg sold to 376 Charolais.
- The straight Angus steers were 15-20 c/kg dearer. The Euro Cross steers fully firm to 10 c/kg better.
- The small penning of cows was close to firm and topped at 306 c/kg.
- Only one bull offered which made 276.2 c/kg
