Numbers eased to 440 cattle this sale, back 600 head. That was on the back of last weeks sale of 1030 head. Once again it was an outstanding quality yarding for all grades represented. Not all regular buyers operated.

- Prime local trade cattle selling to butcher orders sold close to firm, topping at 441.2 c/kg
- Those to backgrounding orders firm to a little dearer
- Yearling steers to processors eased 10 c/kg on average, however some sales were fully firm
- Yearling heifers to processors saw no change, topping at a little over 400 c/kg
- Feeder/Backgrounding orders were fully firm on last week's strong rates
- Light weight yearling steers sold 20 c/kg dearer & sold to a high of 519 c/kg. Heavier weights fully firm, selling generally between 420 to 440.2 c/kg. Steers over 500 kg selling to the lot feeders sold to a high of 434.2 c/kg
- Yearling heifers to backgrounding orders sold to 422 c/kg. No real change
