The second sale for 2023 saw an increase in numbers up double for yarding of 775 head Most grades were represented in a varied market. Not all buyers were present at the rail.

Vealers sold to softer rates, however there was fair competition and the market seems to find a new level.

A better offering of feeder steers and heifers this sale. Popular British Bred, medium weight steers sold 10-15 c/kg & heavier weights gained 10-12 c/kg

Feeder heifers saw the mt competition and sold up to 25 c/kg dearer.

A very good offering heavy export cattle. The best steers sold to \$363.2 c/kg, while heifers reached \$358.2 c/kg

This was slightly back from the sale two weeks ago.

Cows met good competition however sold to cheaper compared to last sae.

Best cows reached 302.2 c/kg, with the majority trading in the 280 to early 290 c/kg for the best D4 & D5 cows

Bulls were 30 c/kg cheaper
