A very good offering heavy export cattle. The best steers sold to\$363.2 c/kg, while heifers reached \$358.2 c/kg

Cows met good competition however sold to cheaper compared to last sae.

Best cows reached 302.2 c/kg, with the majority trading in the 280 to early 290 c/kg for the best D4 & D5 cows

Bulls were 30 c/kg cheaper
