Numbers lifted to 1820 cattle up by 200 head. It was over all a very good penning of cattle most types were represented along with some plain & secrendary types. A full field of buyers attended and operated in a market that was fully firm to dearer in places. The bulk of the yarding was yearling cattle with the heifer portion presenting in forward to fat condition. There were increased numbers of yearling steers suitable for the feedlotters. Prime local trade cattle sold firm to 10 cent dearer & topped at 500 cents. A feature of the sale was an excellent penning of angus feeder steers they sold in larger numbers and improved by 8 to 10 cents with the better pens making 490 cents to 498 cents. Other breeds improved 5 cents mostly selling between 440 to 480 cents. Yearling heifers to processing orders were dearer by 10 to 12 cents while those going to feedlotters sold firm to 5 cents better. Export cattle numbers improved and quality was also better. They sold firm to slightly better with quality a factor. Best 550 kg plus steers reached 500.2 cents. A feature sale of 28 bullocks weighing 808 kg and sold for 478.4 cents returninga healthy result of \$3,865 per head. Cows sold to

130 cents with most heavy cows making 390 to 420 cents. Bulls firm for most a limo bull topped at 134.2 cents.
