A buoyant market found a few more cattle this sale. 430 mostly plain cattle were penned, up 230 head. All buyers were present & trying to operate in another very solid market. Cows made up the biggest percentage of the yarding.

- Very few butcher cattle on offer that sold slightly cheaper
- Feeder steers gained further enthusiasm this week pushing lighter weights to 440 c/kg & 405 c/kg for heavier weights, up 20 c/kg
- Feeder heifers topped at 381.2 c/kg with the majority between 360 – 365 c/kg
- Restocking lighter weight steers topped at 462.2 c/kg, while the heifer portion reached a high of 430 c/kg
- Best prime heavy D4 cows reached a top of 292.2 c/kg, 7c/kg dearer
- Restockers were active on suitable types paying up to 274.2 c/kg
- Bulls reached 307.2 c/kg
