Numbers remained similar for a yard of 325 cattle up 25 head. It was another very good quality yarding with the majority presenting in prime condition. All regular buyers were in attendance and competing in a mostly dearer market. Vealers straight of the cows gained 10 cents to top at 431 cents. Young prime cattle were once again well sort after selling 5 to 10 cents dearer than the previous week. Feeder steers gained 8 to 10 cents while the feeder heifers saw very little change. The return of a supermarket order pushed heavy yearlings & heavy cattle 10 cents on average. Heavy steers & heifers sold 10 to 15 cents dearer. Those with 4 or more teeth traded firm. Cows continued the dearer trend selling 6 to 8 cents dearer. Bulls similar.
