After some very useful rain over the weekend numbers eased to 390 cattle down 60 head. A handy penning of cattle with most grades represented. All regular buyers were in attendance however not all local trade orders operated. Not the numbers of butcher calves this sale. Less competition saw individual sales fully firm while the balance sold slightly cheaper. There were some very good quality feeder steers offered in good lot sizes. They generally sold 5 to 10 cents dearer. Heifers also met solid competition selling 10 cents dearer. Too few heavy steers & heifers to get an accurate quote. Cows were the big improvers with best cows 20 to 30 cents dearer. Best sales reached 226.6 cents & plenty made 210 to 215 cents. Bulls 10 to 15 cents up. Restockers met spirited bidding especially the steer portion, making into the 280 odd cents. Heifer portion sold 210 to 235 cents.
