The last sale for the financial year saw no change in numbers, for a yarding of 485 cattle showing the signs of the very harsh season., however this week saw extra supplementary fed cattle. Prime supplementary fed yearling increased in numbers this week, selling to similar values as last week. The heifer portion sold 10c/kg cheaper, however this was on the back of a very solid market last week. Feeder steers received 5-8 c/kg extra selling to a top of 290 cents. Feeder heifers fully firm. An excellent offering of heavy supplementary fed bullocks. They met solid competition to top at 284.6 c/kg and returned \$1975 per head. Cows met extra demand with buyers struggling to secure their requirements. Best well covered heavy cows reached to 210 c/kg. 5-6 c/kg dearer than previous sale. Bulls 10c/kg dearer. Plain restocking cattle met strong demand for Angus cattle, they finished firm to 5c/kg dearer. However there was an increased offering of cross bred weaners which saw little price change.
