Numbers remained the same for a yarding of 800 head. It was a fairly good quality yarding, especially the heavy export types. Some handy prime yearling cattle, suitable for the local butchers and trade wholesalers. Plenty of plain weaners. All regular buying orders were in place in a solid market for the heavy cattle. Local trade cattle sold 5-8 c/kg dearer for the best. Medium and heavy feeder steers firm to a couple of cents cheaper. Light weight restocking feeders back 5-10c/kg. while the heifer portion gained 10 c/kg. There were some very good supplementary heavy cattle penned. 400kg prime heifers made to 334.2 c/kg, while heavy steers bullocks sold to 337.2 c/kg. Best heavy D4 cows sold to 270 c/kg, dearer by 10-12 c/kg. Medium cows gained 5-6 c/kg. and bulls sold 6 c/kg dearer
