After some very usefull rain numbers were reduced by 315 head for a total yarding of 965 head. There were some good lines of steers & heifers suitable for the lot feeders however overall quality was not to the standard of the previous sale. A bigger buying gallery were present and competed in a much dearer market. Prime local trade cattle to the processors sold 30 to 40 cents dearer. Some heifers sales as high as 50 odd cents. Light weight steers sold 80 cents above the sale 2 weeks ago. Medium & heavy weights 40 to 50 cents daerer. There were good numbers of yearling heifers both to frird & slaughter. Good lines of well bred angus heifers sold up to 60 cents dearer & topped at 286.2 cents. Those to processing ordres gained similar price increaces. Not large numbres of heavy export types. Best heavy weight steers sold to a high of 266.4 cents or 40 cents better. Cows saw up to 40 cents better prices and best heavy cows sold to 235 cents. Bulls sold as much as 70 cents dearer. Restocking types also saw significant price gains selling 60 to 80 cents dearer in places.
