Numbers increased to 750 cattle, up 200 head from last sale. Rainfall has been patchy in the area with some pockets receiving very little. A full field of buyers were in attendance and competing in a dearer market. Feedlotters competed strongly to secure numbers & put a solid floor in the prime yearling steers & heifers.

- Prime trade steers were fully firm, the heifer portion gained 10-15c/kg
- Feedlotters competed & pushed prices 15-20 c/kg dearer for the heifer portion
- The few heavy steers were firm to 15c/kg for a select few.
- A large percentage of the yarding was made up of cows. A fair selection across all categories.
- Best heavy D4 cows topped at 275.2 c/kg – 16 – 18c/kg higher than the previous week.
- The strongest activity was seen in the boner cow offering as they sold 20-30 c/kg dearer on average.
- Plain cows were keenly sought as they sold 10 c/kg dearer
- Bulls were up 5-10 c/kg
