Numbers fell this sale to draw for 450 head as many producers were unable to get cattle out due to the wet conditions. It was another exceptional quality yarding with the majority presenting in prime condition. All regular buyers were in attendance along with the return of a supermarket order.

- A beautiful selection of milk vealers and light trade yearlings met solid demand mostly from Southern Processors. They sold fully firm rates; however, a select few individuals did not quite get to the highs of a fortnight ago.
- Prime yearling heifers 370 to 400kg sold 5-10 c/kg dearer
- Feeder steers and heifers both unchanged
- A very smart line of heavy steers sold 10-20 c/kg dearer. Quality, condition, and numbers a contributing factor.
- Heavy weight yearling heifers suitable for the supermarket trade gained 10 c/kg.
- Cows numbers eased; however the market was fully firm.
- Bulls saw no change.
- Restocking types were in high demand after the rain and sold 10-15 c/kg better
