Numbers eased to 350 cattle down 120 head. Overall quality & condition was again mostly plain however there were a few good pens of well finished pens. Best prime cattle selling to the local butchers sold slightly cheaper 5 cents while the balance slipped further 10 to 12 cents. Yearling steers/heifers over 380 kg met solid competition to be fully firm. The heavier end of the feeder steers (mostly light to medium weights offered) sold firm to 5 cents cheaper. The lighter end fell 10 to 15 cents. The majority of the yearling heifers were more suited to the restockers & backgrounders rather than feedlotters. They meet weaker demand to sell 20 cents cheaper. Odd individual heavy steer over 450 kg sold unchanged. Cows fell 15 cents for the best heavy o4 however light & medium weight boner cows sold close to firm. Bulls 5 to 10 cents back. Plain restocking cattle fell 20 to 30 cents.
