Numbers climbed to 580 cattle, a rise of 140 head. Not all operators were in attendance in a mostly cheaper market.

- Yearlings once again made up the bulk of the yarding with good numbers of both prime and feeder types.
- There were some exceptional vealers penned which sold to fully firm rates from previous sales
- Angus feeder steers 370-420kg eased by 20 c/kg. Heavy weights fell 20-25 c/kg other. Other breeds fell 10 c/kg
- Bit the numbers of suitable feeder heifers this sale
- Processors were more selective in their purchasers this week. Supermarket operators were again active. They generally sold 20-30 c/kg cheaper
- Cows were only slightly cheaper being 4-5 c/kg due to extra buying orders.
- Restockers were again active, however not to the high rates of previous weeks
- Bulls dropped by 20 c/kg
