Numbers remained high for a yarding of 805 cattle back by 100 head. All regular buyers were at the rail however not all operated in a much cheaper market. A better selection of prime vealers/local trade cattle were offered. The best vealers topped at 505 cents that was similar to last sale for the odd selected beast however most fell 10 to 20 cents. Yearling cattle made up the bulk of the yarding. Best steer selling to feedlot orders sold to a high of 480.2 cents with big variances for cross bred & off types some sales could have been 100 cents cheaper. Yearling heifers has similar results with major reductions. Heavy prime yearling cattle along with bullocks & any export types saw very reduced demand. Best heavy weight sold to 376.2 cents with the majority selling between 340 to 370 cents. Export weight heifers from younger types right through to those with teeth mostly sold 290 to 330 cents. Cows also eased with best pen of cows sold to a high of 315 cents back 30 cents. Bulls also back 30 cents.
