Numbers remained similar for a yarding of 260 cattle. It was a fair to good quality yarding. All regular buyers were in attendance however not all operating. The majority of the yarding consisted of cows and feeder steers. Some good quality prime vealers met solid competition to be fully firm on last weeks dearer rates, topping at 3.05c/kg. There were some well bred Angus feeder/backgrounding steers in good pen lots. They lost 5-6 c/kg on last weeks rates. An excellent penning of heavy prime conditioned cows and heifers. With the return of one major exporter, they gained everything of last weeks cheaper rates to finish 10c/kg dearer, topping at 2.10 c/kg for best heavy weights and 10-14c/kg dearer for good clean meaty medium weight cows. 10 bulls reached 219.2 c/kg up 5c/kg from last sale.
