A slightly smaller yarding this week saw 325 good quality cattle penned. Down 90 head. Principally most regular buyers were present in a solid market. A very good consignment of over 100 steers 470 to 650 kg was penned. The biggest percentage of the yarding had plenty of weight with only a handful of vealers penned. Prime vealers sold firm to 4-5c/kg cheaper. Prime yearlings selling to trade processing orders were mostly 5-6c/kg back. A very good run of feeder steers attracted solid competition. The lighter/medium weights were very close to firm, only quality related changes. There was an increased offering of heavier weight feeder steers 470-550 kg on some sales. Heavy steers/bullocks lifted 5c/kg, topping @ 393.8c/kg for 600kg. A smaller offering of cows saw a very similar result to last sale with best heavy D4 cows making 307.6 c/kg. Bulls firm.
