An excellent yarding of 600 cattle, the majority presenting in prime condition. All regular buyers were in attendance & operating in a dearer market. Sufficient numbers of prime vealers sold to 20c/kg dearer with local butchers competing with Southern orders Yearlings made up the biggest percentage of the yarding. There were enough to suit both the processors & feedlotter

Processors topped at 415 c/kg for steers, which saw a gain of 10 c/kg

The heifer portion reached a high of 430 c/kg, up by 15 c/kg

Feedlotter competed strongly on an excellent offering of Angus steers. They sold 15-20 c/kg dearer. The heavier end 440-500kg topped at 439 c/kg to average 430 c/kg

Heavy steers 500kg plus sold between 39 to 410 c/kg

The lighter & medium weight steers to feedlot & backgrounders sold to a high of 483.2 c/kg

Cows were firm to 3 c/kg cheaper than the previous sale

Bulls saw no change
