Number were reduced to 1100 head this sale back 250 cattle. Overall quality continues to be very mixed however there were some good fat cattle offered. Not all regular buying orders operated with most starting to fill up before the christmas break. Best supplemented trade cattle sold to a slightly dearer trend topping at 305 cents for a select few. Prime heavy steers slipped 20 cents Feeder orders were again active with well bred popular breeds fully firm. Backward steers fell 5 cents. Forward conditioned heifers sold very similar. Cows slipped a further 20 cents with less buyers at the rail. Best heavy cows topping at 215 cents. Plain restocking cows with a couple of extra orders sold firm to 10 cents dearer in places. There was an increased penning of plain weaners. With extra outside orders in place they met good competition however sold to a weaker trend. Bulls back 10 to 20 cents.
