It was another light yarding with only 270 cattle drawn for. Light & medium weight restocking type weaners made up the bulk of the yarding. Not all regular buyers operated, however the market continues to grow legs every time we receive more rain. Restocking orders underpinned a very solid market.

- An exceptional consignment of properly finished British bred yearling heifers stood out in today's offering.
- Processors competed fiercely to secure requirements, with the lead topping at 375.2 c/kg
- Light weight steers reached a top of 458.2 c/kg, while the medium weights ranged from 400 to 425c/kg. Fully firm to 5c/kg dearer from last sale
- Restocking heifers gained a further 5-10c/kg, reaching 378.2 c/kg
- A smaller offering of cows saw restockers pay up to 300 c/kg, up 10-12 c/kg from last week.
- Insufficient heavy prime cows made it hard to gain an accurate quote
- Lack of Bulls also made it difficult to gauge
