Numbers were reduced by 250 head for a total yarding of 550 cattle. Most regular buyers were present and competing in a mostly cheaper market. There were some handy yearling cattle penned, the majority being on the lighter side of 280-320 kg they generally eased 5-8 c/kg for the well finished/ supplementary fed cattle. Plain yearlings slipped a further 5 c/kg. Not the yarding of heavy cattle this sale. Once again there was a very good yarding of cows, with the biggest percentage presented in prime condition. Best heavy D4 cows fell 12 -17 c/kg topping at 253 c/kg. Medium weight cows fell 10c/kg. Feeder steers sold similar to last week, while feeder heifers lost 5 c/kg. However some of this was due to a drop in quality. Bulls lost 10-20 c/kg. ONce again there was reasonable numbers of plain weaners. Some are starting to be presented in a backward condition and plenty of secondary types. They struggled to hold last weeks prices, 10-20 c/kg back more

secondary types.
